## Freda Stumps

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Site: ST-060 TFL 39 Block 1
Alpine Mainline

We visited a recently cut yellow cedar and mountain hemlock forest cutblock ST-060. In some areas the logs had not been removed.
The provincial forest cover maps give this stand an age of 357 years (polygon ID 46655416).
Our track and photographs are recorded on the June 2020 Operational Information Map/ Stillwater Forest Operation (OIM). This file is available as a .kmz file. We noted differences between the cutblock area on the ground and that which is indicated on the Operational Information Map. On the ground, cutblock ST-060 is in several separate pieces which are spread over a larger area than is indicated on the OIM map.
A variety of stump sizes were sampled. Sample stumps were selected based on size, ease of reading the rings, less rot in the centre, and proximity to the road. In one site, on more moderate terrain where a feller-buncher had been used to cut the trees, the rough cut rendered the rings unreadable. At this site only stump height and diameter were measured.
